On the night of Thursday, May 4th, 2023, Deputy Philip Chandler responded to a call made by an employee of the Stranger Creek Library. According to said employee, a patron using the exterior book-drop noticed a man badly injured in the alley behind the building.

Upon responding Deputy Chandler observed the man was extremely mangled and deceased. Tire tracks indicated he was run over by an automobile multiple times.

On his person the Deputy found a wallet with his I.D. and confirmed his identity as Daniel Miller. He had \$300 cash in his wallet, likely ruling out robbery as motive to the crime. The responding officer also found a handwritten note in his coat pocket.

Members of the book club the victim attended that night were briefly questioned. A statement from a woman who lives adjacent to said alley was also taken.

The library has no security cameras. The neighbor had an Amazon security camera on her porch, facing the opposite direction of where the incident took place.

Investigators are confirming witness statements and suspect alibis as well as gathering additional information. They are pursuing all leads.
